- Teacher Assessment outcomes at the end of KS1 (Year 2) are informed by the results of the nonstatutory English reading, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar and mathematics tests.
- These statistics cover the attainment of Year 6 pupils who took assessments in Summer 2024. These pupils experienced disruption to their learning during the pandemic, particularly at the end of Year 2 and in Year 3.
- There will be no progress measures from KS1 to KS2 due to the pandemic (no published data) when Year 6 were in Year 2.
- Year 6 cohort:
  - Made up of 28 pupils 61% boys and 39% girls

Average Scaled Score – Attainment (End of KS2/Year 6)

- 28% of pupils were inwardly mobile (high level of need)
- 7% of pupils with English as an additional language
- High level of need with 11% on SEND Support
- 32% of pupils in receipt of PPG

- Year 6 Teacher absent for a prolonged period
