**Response by Abby Bassett (Head of School): 19.5.24**

Thank you to all of you, as pupils, for completing your annual pupil surveys. We really do value your feedback and it helps us to plan our next steps. You will see that there is also an analysis for your individual classes and your class teacher has completed a 'class based' analysis.

It is fantastic to see that the vast majority of pupils agree in almost all of the different areas. It is wonderful to see that you like being at this school and are learning a lot. The staff spend a considerable amount of time planning your lessons, as well as additional trips and enrichments, so we pleased to see that you find your lessons interesting and fun. We hope that you have enjoyed the vast array of after school clubs that have been on offer this year and we hope to see the number attending continuing to increase next year.

We understand that the level of challenge in terms of your learning increases as you move through the school and you recognise that you have to work hard but you are also equipped with a set of strategies for when you are 'stuck' in your learning – this is in line with us being a Visible Learning school. Some of your teachers have already started to undertake a 'Thinking Matters' programme with the rest of them starting in September. This will help you develop in this area further.

I have really enjoyed my time with all of you that have attended Gardening Club this year. You shared your wonderful ideas and demonstrated great resilience. Remember, to continue to do so, in your class and school pupil parliament groups. You will be pleased to know that the Vision and Values Pupil Parliament group are currently in the process of applying for more funding (like with did for the Playground Climber and Gazebo) to further enhance the school garden. I will keep you posted on how we get on.

The vast majority of you have embraced the new behaviour policy this year, in line with being a Rights Respecting and Trauma Informed School. We know you all enjoy our weekly Celebration Assembly and it has been wonderful to recognise when you have all gone 'above and beyond'. The Vision and Values Pupil Parliament group are taking on ideas for ways of enhancing the raffle prizes for next year so please make sure that you share ideas. It is important that if you have reached steps, in line with the behaviour policy, that you recognise the reasons as to why and change this behaviour next time. We will continue to further embed the policy for the rest of this academic year and into next year.

I see that home learning is the only area in which it was the majority area, rather than the vast majority. This is something which we will look at as a school, and take on your ideas, for next year.
