Aren't = Are not    You're = You are


## Homophones

Homophones are words that sound the same but have different meanings.

## Direct Speech

**Inverted commas** always come in pairs! Any **punctuation** needs to be inside them.

“This is how to use inverted commas!” explained Mrs Carter.



## Punctuation

### Writing Lists

Lists start with a **colon** and every item should be separated with a **comma**.

Mrs Carter expects you all to: try your best, ask questions, work hard and smile.

## Grammar

Determiner

Noun

**Noun:** An object, person, or place.

**Adverb:** Modifies the verb.

Preposition

**Adjective:** Describes the noun.

Noun

Beyond the forest, the troll hid menacingly under the rickety

**Fronted Adverbial**

Determiner

**Verb:** An action or doing word.

**Determiner:** Introduces the noun and specifies which one, or how many.

### Preposition

Shows time, location or position.

# Make your writing exciting!

## Try a different sentence type!

### Simple

One **thing** happens.

e.g. **The cat sat** on the mat.

### Compound

One **thing** + **connective** + another **thing**.

e.g. **The cat sat** on the mat **and purred**.

### Complex

**Magic 5** + one **thing** + **comma** + another **thing**.

e.g. **While the cat sat** on the mat, **the dog ate**.

## Drop in a clause!

Use an embedded clause to add more detail to your writing! **Embedded clauses** tell us extra information about a person, place or object.

,whose ,who... ,which ,that...,

Mrs Carter, **who was extremely happy**, had just finished reading her book.

Launceston, **which was oddly sunny**, was busy with crowds of shoppers.
