The feedback from the pupil survey indicates encouraging outcomes. All pupils have demonstrated good behaviour and the vast majority have expressed feeling supported in their learning journey, citing significant academic progress. It is commendable that the students are also being encouraged to develop awareness about maintaining good health. While most pupils appreciate the value of the current home learning, there is a consensus that enhancements are needed.

Discussions held during Class Parliament sessions, mirrored the view in this survey which highlighted a strong desire for more outdoor learning opportunities.
